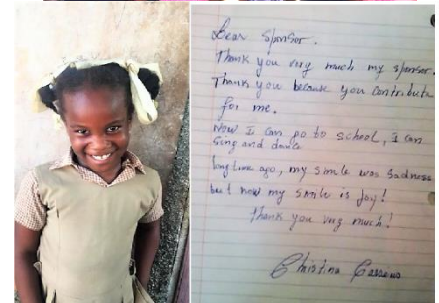


Wow we give God all the glory for everything accomplished in Haiti in 2021, and that He has joined us together in prayer and support. These precious people need the love of Christ especially now. In a country reeling with unemployment, lack of infrastructure, adequate medical care, and basic needs, they suffered the assassination of President Jovenel Moïse, gangs taking hostages, controlling ports, gas and food supply, and an earthquake. How awesome to directly help with food, water, and supplies because of people that generously donated! How bright a hope has been shown through this mission because of Jesus' great plan. A smaller quake hit Monday in another mission area, but they are so scared they are sleeping outside!



The boys in our home are all thriving in school and spiritually. They are being trained as young Christian men, even leading church services. One wants to be pastor, another a doctor. They are tutored weekly in English. Hallelujah!

Over 80 students were sponsored for school. Their thank you letters are so precious too. So many lives changed. This little girl's said "Now I can go to school. I can sing and dance. Long time go my smile was sadness, but now my smile is joy!". You can change a child's life too by becoming a sponsor!



There is another orphanage we help feed monthly. Earlier, and once again due to unrest in their town, they were forced to flee. The new landlord decided he did not want children and kept threatening the pastor, but we rented another safe space for them. A reservoir was given to another orphanage, along with 2 water filters. A new well was provided, and funds received for more to be installed this year.



A new home was built for the Louissant family, and they were blessed with furnishings, school and provisions. This was a dream since 2019.

An elderly man, Nathan, suffers with diabetes and his prostrate. He is provided a caretaker to assist with bathing, cooking and medical needs. Imagine he was your grandfather. We won't abandon him!



Many emergency surgeries, C-sections, and medical care was given. We have numerous photos that are too graphic to share. 2 different grandmothers broke their arms: One required extensive surgery. Look at her smile now! The little boy is doing well! Thank you for investing in life!



This summer we provided several medical clinics treating hundreds, gave clothing, food and gospel tracts with love.



This Christmas, a day of celebration for 150+ children was given where they received 2 meals, had Bible lessons, treats, and enjoyed games.

Several houses were painted to prepare for Christmas too!



The **Haiti Blessing** project was a wonderful success. Thank you to those that donated for food, goats and chickens! The recipients also received a special booklet about God and His love for them.

That is the word Jesus used in John 3:16! You may not know *Sozo* is used many times in the Bible, such as when the woman was immediately and powerfully healed by touching the hem of Jesus garment in Matthew 9:22, and also when the disciples woke Jesus from sleep when they thought they would die in the boat in Matthew 8:25. Wow, what a beautiful realization to understand so much more about what He meant and what He has done. What addicts do is not who they are, and Jesus has already paid for freedom. He didn't come to make bad people good, but to make dead people live! *SOZO-Life* will be a separate non-profit, with separate accounting and board.
