Without you, they could not have the privilege of education and a better future. We are so very thankful for every single one that prays for and partners together to bring joy and hope to the desperately poor and now terrorized brothers and sisters in Haiti.

Haiti is still very much in crisis. Please pray for our young director, Esdras and his wife, Develyn, their daughter, Ester and 2 boys, Lordson and Samuel, and all the boys they raise as their own in our boys' home. We have shared over the past year about the violent gang activity that is crippling this country. Innocent people are killed including hundreds of police officers, women and girls are raped, and hostage taking continues to increase.

Just last week, Esdras received several anonymous death threats, and on his way home one day, several gang members **attempted to take him hostage** by blocking the road with trees and surrounding his truck suddenly but **thank God** he was able to frantically swerve and escape as they shot at his vehicle. We know he is always in the Presence of God, and we

also know God instructs us to pray for one another so we ask you to lift him specifically and his family in prayer to our Mighty Father. Please pray for their country too!

Esdras risks his life every day to serve others. He has had guns pulled on him, forced to lay face down on the road, been robbed, and generally been a target of persecution. He even adopted his daughter, Ester, as a starving, uncared for toddler and before he was married, when he could hardly provide for himself. This is what love looks like and he shines every day. Please pray for this warrior and his family!
