God continues to amaze and display His awesome loving-kindness. An incredible partner that was **"broken hearted and incensed"** over the evil activities shared last month simply blew us away with his letter below that wrapped his **"gift from Jesus"**. This message from the Lord had to be shared:

"It was relatively easy [to pray] for the Pastor, Esdras and the orphans, but when I started to think of the mob and the gangs it was a different story. Initially I thought of asking God to bring vengeance against those who had done (and were doing) such wicked things (particularly to His people), but was made quickly aware that I was thinking like the sons of thunder who wanted to call fire down from heaven, and were operating in the wrong spirit. Not wanting to follow their lead, I asked my Heavenly Father to help me pray for those who had done (and were doing) these wicked things. Oh, how wonderfully He helped! As I recounted what they were doing I recognized that they had been blinded by the god of this world, and were his pawns under his leadership to contend against the work and love of God. Their hearts had been hardened by the deceitfulness of sin and they had bought into the lie that right was wrong and wrong was right. They had been drawn into such a bad place by the master of deceit that I didn't think they could even help themselves.

With that framework, it was brought to mind that God is plenteous in mercy (as Jonah testified to), takes no pleasure in the death of the wicked, and is willing that none should perish but that all should come to repentance and living faith. That was His heart for even these angry and violent in Haiti. I was enabled then to pray for God's loving conviction to come upon them, not as a cover for vengeance against them but as the only way for them to escape the eternal destruction that awaits. If God does not open their eyes to see and their hearts to understand their desperate condition and need of a Savior, they stand no chance at all of escaping eternal fire. It is out of His divine love that He sends His Holy Spirit to convict the world of sin, righteousness and judgment. It's for our good! We know that where sin abounds, there does grace much more abound, and I found myself praying with love, earnest intensity and confidence for God to move and help each one, for Romans 2:4 says it is the goodness of God that leads us to repentance.

What amazing grace!!! He turned my troubled thinking about the mob and gangs to prayer born of His love for their good. I know it was His heart, and He encouraged me so well with it. He helps us to pray when we don't know how (and ask).

I wanted to let you know how your mission is working at home (in me) as well as abroad."

Wow! God bless our friend, one after His own heart. Let his be the prayer of us all.
