



New Children's Home in August!

We took over Bon Secours Orphanage, which we have helped since 2017. Pastor Ludor could not continue because of his health. Gangs killed his wife in front of the children and burned the orphanage in 2023.

A large home was rented near our Acts 1:8 Children's home, with beds and essential needs. For each of the 26 kids, Esdras has been meeting with any family at the tribunal to officially be appointed guardian. Some of the children had no representation so another place was found for them, and some returned to family rather than permanently move.

We also just renewed the lease on Acts 1:8 Children's Home in September.

Emergency Exit! Because the gangs were going door to door and murdering so many innocent people, and especially to protect our girls and women from attrocities, both homes had to be abandoned and everyone moved to safety in a church building in the mountains. Our mission is now permanently moving north near Cap Haitien. Doctor Ashlyn and his family, and Pastor Ludor are among the adults also relocating.

Esdras is desperately trying to find transporation and housing there for everyone. Personal vehicles are not allowed on gang-controlled roads, only public transporation. Hurricane Melissa delayed the trip due to heavy rains, flooding, and land slides making the dirt roads even more dangerous. We know the Lord will make a way when it is safe. These kids are afraid and have been through so much, and this trip will be long and scary.

Please keep all them in prayer. We have no idea physically or spiritually what they are facing.But GOD!

Can you help us help them? Would you ask your church group, family or friends?

Even though \$13,000 down for housing and supplies that had to be abandoned, we are trusting God will supply all their needs in Cap Haitien through the kindness and generosity of each of you.
