Wow! **10 years ago**, in February, our lives were enriched beyond imagination (Ephesians 3:20-21!) during our first mission trip to Haiti with Mt. Olivet Baptist Church, now Acts 1:8 by Mrs. Billie Cooper. What an incredible blessing and how absolutely humbling to be part of answered prayers of our brothers and sisters there, desperately poor but rich in the tender care of the Lord who has connected us all to be part of saving and changing lives through the love of Christ Jesus.

We can never express our deepest gratitude for everyone that supports and prays for this mission and for them. All glory to God who joined all together, and sincere thanks for those that partner to share what they have with those whose very lives depend on precious responses to their cries for help. *All donations are always used directly for mission needs and neither we nor our board members ever receive any compensation.*

How amazing that our God who makes every single snowflake that we just enjoyed entirely unique! We may not see that with our eyes, but how magnificent! Even more awesome, He has sons and daughters you won't see this side of heaven, but how sweet to be connected in Spirit through the grace of God. The only thing that melts is your heart!

Highlights over the years –

- Started a school sponsorship program with 20 students in 2016, to over 125 in 2019, until riots and gangs paralyzed the country. This year we have 56: 29 in the north, and 17 in other areas.
- One student started medical school 2025
- Leased a home and built bunk beds for an orphanage in 2016, which became our Acts 1:8 children's home in 2017.
- Began helping Bon Secours orphanage in 2018 by building a latrine, rejuvenating living facilities and providing monthly support and medical care. Leased housing, provided mattresses, and needs. Pastor's wife killed by gangs and orphanage burned down in 2023. Took them over in 2025.
- Both orphanages forced to abandon all and flee up north and combined in 2025
- Built 6 houses including one for a disabled widow, for a family – grandma with cancer and special needs daughter, an older man with cancer
- Rebuilt an earthquake damaged church/school 2017
- New balcony and roof for a church/school 2024
- Revitalize a community medical office, install solar panels and lighting in 2017. Fully staffed with 1 full time and 1 part time doctor, 2 nurses, receptionist/manager and medicines in its pharmacy for the community 2024
- Led mission teams until rioting, gangs and Covid made travel impossible. Thousands of people received medical care and medicines, along with shoes, clothing and gifts. The Gospel of Jesus Christ was shared at each remote medical clinic, tracts given, and all gifts say "Jezi Renmen Ou" (Jesus Love You in Haitian Creole)



- Shipped a concrete block making machine, 2 generators and a ton of medical supplies 2020
- Shipped thousands of manna packs, school supplies and clothes inside a box truck. 2020
- Built a beautiful church and school with latrine in the Larot community in the mountains! 2022

- Providing medical care including emergency surgeries, C-sections, and critical care, TB treatments, etc. Many babies and mamas saved!
- Purchased and distributed thousands of pounds of rice and beans, including Hurricane Matthew, earthquake and flooding victims
- Given hundreds of goats, chickens and thousands of pounds of rice, beans, oil & spaghetti to the hungry
- Distributed personal hygiene items, clothes, shoes and Shoes That Grow, backpacks, school supplies
- Distributed many Lifestraw Community Water Filters that removes Cholera, Typhoid, bacteria and viruses
- Showed **The Jesus Film**, hosted Christian concert and gave hundreds of "The Greatest Story Ever Told" salvation tracts 2017
- Shipped a Jeep filled with a generator and supplies 2017
- Ministering in the men's jail and giving over 700 gift bags including a gospel tract 2018
- New community well 2020
- Sponsored 40-day prayer event with a group of pastors from all over the country 2023
- Wednesday program sharing about our Lord and meal to over 60 children and adults in the mountains!
- Support and supplies given to a pastor who opened a new school with over 40 students 2023
- Fed over 700 police, prisoners, and poor in St. Marc and other community meals 2024
